New York started the season 1-4, but won seven of its last nine games to earn the AFC East title on the final day of the season. The surge continued against the Colts, as the Jets recorded their first postseason victory since 1998. On only the Jets' fifth offensive play on the day, QB Chad Pennington's screen pass to Richie Anderson turned into a 56-yard score. The play was the longest of Anderson's 10-year career and the longest play for the Jets in 1998. After a field goal, Ray Mickens recovered a Troy Walters fumbled kickoff, and LaMont Jordan's one-yard run made

it 17-0. That lead became 24-0 with 37 seconds remaining in the first half when Pennington rolled out and found Santana Moss in the right corner of the end zone. The score matched the Jets' biggest playoff output in a half. Chad Morton ran the second-half kickoff 70 yards to the Indy 19 setting up a 39-yard field goal by Hall. Rookie tight end Chris Baker caught his first career touchdown pass, a three-yard reception late in the third quarter.
